3	New Business	Christine	1, 2, 3	Christmas Lunch?	<ul> <li>Lunch is scheduled for Dec 18.</li> <li>Paula was able to confirm the Lunch Lady with \$2 lunch donation. The price had gone up a little bit, but we are going to cover the cost to keep it at \$2.</li> <li>There was some talk about Mr. G coming back dressed up as Santa. Perhaps Lindsay was going to ask him (as he is her dad).</li> <li>It will be in the Church Hall. Grade 7/8 will help with set up and take down. Chantelle, Lindsay and Amy have said they will help.</li> <li>The food comes in and we have to sort it into the 5 different meals. We usually have 2 sittings. We may need to find a couple more volunteers, and could perhaps ask for some Grade 7/8s if needed.</li> <li>We bought cutlery (forks) and napkins last year. The Lunch Lady provided candy canes that Santa handed out, but without confirmation we would need to consider the candy canes too. There are 215 kids in the school. It's a very tricky time for families by asking for food bank or financial donations. We want to be mindful that it is often a tricky</li> </ul>

					season and potentially a tricky year for families. That said, we are faith based and its important to give when you can. As long as the request doesn't add pressure to families that already be strained then it should be fine. Would need to advertise ahead of time so everyone doesn't arrive with Tim's.  • Potential for running a tea/ coffee station in the hallway outside the gym by donation only, and allowing for food bank donations if possible.  o If we go forward, Jess can potentially bring a large coffee maker, and Paula has a large one for hot water only. Christine and/ or Jess can buy coffee cups with lids at Costco, as well as hot chocolate packs and/or tea bags.  o Paula would need to ensure that there are garbage cans in the hall or gym as well, and would advertise in the newsletter.  • Request that Paula include in the newsletter that Mrs. Langlois' class is making programs that will be available.  Church Pageant:  • They have volunteers for the choir but may need some for the play.

We could do it in the middle of the week to capture more kids' availability.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Tentatively plan for Wed March 6<sup>th</sup>. Its an all-day event – different classes go at different times so not all day for everyone.</li> <li>Last year we sold glow sticks and snacks and drinks. We would need volunteers in shifts for the entire day to sell. Last year we made a decent amount of money from that activity and the kids really enjoyed it, so lets plan for that to go forward.
